Our Recent Community Involvement include:

- Bardavon and La Voz magazine with the support of Radio Kingston presented a screening of Disney Pixar's Coco, with a live performance by the 20-member National Folk Orchestra of Mexico, at UPAC, in October 2023.
- La Voz in association with the Fisher Center 20th Anniversary Community Celebration featured a free special performance from Latin Grammy Award-winning Flor de Toloache, in the summer of 2023

- Organizer of panel discussions at Bard College to educate a wider audience on Latino issues, such as Hispanic Immigrants in Rural New York, The Local Movement for Immigration Reform, Human Trafficking from Mexico to New York, Latinos in Local Politics, and Sanctuary Movements in the Hudson Valley, among others.

- Organized fundraising events with a strong cultural aspect, including salsa classes, concerts, Latin jazz, art auction and theater plays in Spanish through the Hudson Valley.

- Member of: TEAM Newburgh and its street outreach arm; BAT (Bringing Agencies Together) in Dutchess, Ulster, Orange and Sullivan counties; chair of Mano-a-Mano Ulster County, Eastern Dutchess Rural Health Network; Sullivan Latino Alliance; and Healthy Black and Latino Coalition (Poughkeepsie and Newburgh), among others.
